<i>Topics of the discipline</i>	Obligations to compensate for damage (torts) in the system of obligations under the civil legislation of Ukraine. General grounds and conditions of liability for damage caused by unlawful actions. Obligations to cause damage to property, life and health of an individual. Liability for damage caused by persons with various disabilities. Obligations to cause damage by acts of power, bodies carrying out operational and investigative activities, pre-trial investigation, prosecutor's office and court. Features of compensation for damage caused by a source of increased danger. Peculiarities of compensation for damage caused as a result of a crime and extraordinary circumstances. Peculiarities of compensation for damage caused as a result of defects in goods, works (services).
